




LEC Master Plan Current Phase

This current phase focuses on community engagement to create a shared vision and community-informed site concepts.






Visioning Workgroup Purpose

An **advisory body** convened to collaborate with the project team to develop a **shared vision** for the future of the Lane Events Center and advise on **potential design concepts** that reflect community priorities, preferences, and needs.



Visioning Workgroup Objectives

- Understand and identify community needs, priorities, and values through review and analysis of public input.
- Contribute to the development of a shared vision.
- Provide feedback on proposed design concepts.
- Evaluate potential design concepts that align with the community's aspirations and the LEC's long-term goals.




Participants suggested simplifying some of the language and adding a Guiding Principle that reflects LEC as a community asset.



April Open House Summary




Flexible, Multi-Use Spaces Strong support for multi-use spaces that can host events, recreation, support emergency services, and local business activities.



Hotel Feedback

Mixed opinions: some saw economic benefits, others raised concerns about size, traffic, and neighborhood fit.



Green Space & Access

High value placed on trees, parks, and better walking connections especially to Amazon Creek.

Key Themes and Takeaways



Participants shared that the museum is a valued cultural resource and encouraged its continued presence.



Lane County History Museum

Traffic & Safety

Concerns about traffic and neighborhood impacts. Strong emphasis on safe access for people walking and biking.

KEY ELEMENTS

1. MAIN ENTRY

Enhance at Jefferson

2. CONVENTION CENTER

Renovate and expand existing building

3. ICE ARENA

Renovate existing building

4. LIVESTOCK PAVILION

Renovate to provide improved event and competition space

5. MULTI-USE BUILDING

- Flexible use building designed to accommodate events or Fair programming.
- Potential room for indoor track and field and/or increased indoor sports area.
- Potential space for year-round concerts including during Fair.

6. MULTI-USE BUILDING

 Flexible use building designed to accommodate events or Fair programming, including animal shows.

7. PAVILION

• Flexible open air building for gathering and events.

8. ENHANCED OPEN SPACE

 Improvements to create outdoor picnic and event space, including enhanced space along Amazon Creek.

9. PARKING / EVENT SPACE


Open asphalt areas for vehicle parking and event use.

10. OVERFLOW PARKING

Overflow for large events

11. MULTI-USE BUILDING

- Flexible use building designed to accommodate events or Fair programming.
- Potential seasonal second sheet of ice.
